**Service Engine Soon Codes** - Trouble Codes > Check Engine Light Trouble Codes for Old and New cars and Trucks. Some Vehicle Specific Codes. Full list of OBD II Diagnostic Trouble Codes. If your Check engine light is on you may have a serious problem. Scan your codes and follow the chart to determine what the code means. Some parts stores will scan your codes for free. The system returns OBD diagnostic trouble codes beginning with either P0 or P1. The P0 codes are generic, the same for all makes and models of cars. The P1 codes are proprietary, established independently by each automobile manufacturer. Equis Products provides a database of most codes that can be searched. The check engine warning light is also known as a service engine soon light or a MIL (malfunction indicator light). Fortunately though your car's computer system is programmed to identify the problem by producing a trouble code which will point you in the direction of the problem and determine if the car is safe to drive or not. It's what almost every motorist has to go through once in a while: the Check Engine or Service Engine Soon light. If this warning light stays on, it means that your vehicle's computer has detected a problem that can affect your vehicle's fuel economy and emissions.
